

## 2019-20 APPLICATION INFORMATION:

Thank you to all of the graduated high school students who are interested in applying for the scholarships that we will be providing for the 2019–20 academic year. As you already know for this year only, the application process is different. Scholarships will go to students who qualify for the “Promise Program” at San Diego’s Community Colleges. If you are going to a four-year college in San Diego County, the scholarship is not available to you.

### Requirements:

#### Student Eligibility Criteria

- Students must be designated as a “Promise Student.”
- Students must have resided in San Diego County for the last 12 months
- Students must be first-time college students.
- Students must have graduated in 2019 from a high school in San Diego County.
- Students must be enrolled in one of the district community colleges
- Students must be enrolled full time.
- Students must complete an application for Financial Aid (FASFA or a Dream Act Application).
- Students must demonstrate financial need.
- Students must be a California resident for financial aid eligibility purposes.

Colleges will include in their application material, an authorization to release the awarded student’s name and grades to the SDCCSF Board of Directors.
